

# Installing FieryOptimized2.joboptions Adobe Acrobat Distiller Settings

## Overview

EFI has developed a PDF setting to use with Adobe Acrobat Distiller, Adobe Creative Suite/Cloud and the Adobe PDF Printer driver to create PDF files optimized for printing to Fiery Driven™ printers.

The Acrobat Distiller Settings: FieryOptimized2.joboptions can be downloaded from the EFI Download Center at [w3.efi.com/fiery/fiery-support/download/](http://w3.efi.com/fiery/fiery-support/download/):

- Click on the **Application Software and Tools** tab.
- In the **Select Software** area, select **Fiery Distiller Settings**.
- In the **Select Version** area, select **Fiery Distiller Settings verified**.
- Click on the **Find** button.

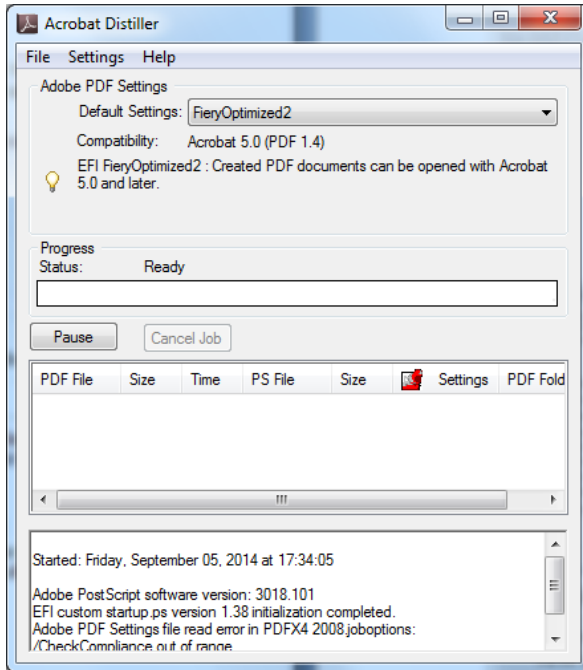
# Installing FieryOptimized2.joboptions Adobe Acrobat Distiller Settings

**Import the setting FieryOptimized2 to create PDF files using one of the following methods:**

## Adobe Acrobat Distiller

Import FieryOptimized2 into Acrobat Distiller:

- Open Adobe Acrobat Distiller, and drag-and-drop the file FieryOptimized2.joboptions into the Acrobat Distiller window.

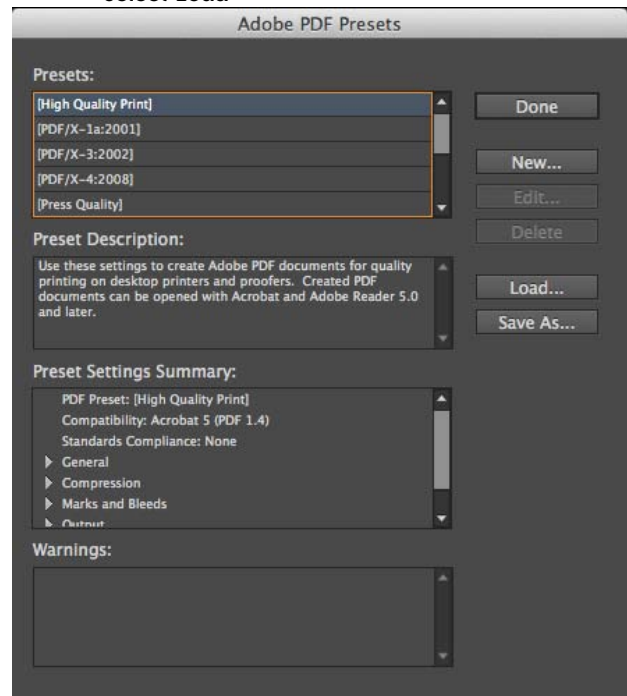

## Adobe InDesign:

Import the FieryOptimized2 into Adobe InDesign:

- Open Adobe InDesign
- Select the Adobe PDF Preset from the File menu.
- In the Adobe PDF Presets dialog window, select Load



- Locate and open the file FieryOptimized2.joboptions.
